Mission Statement:

Building brighter futures through exceptional behavioral health services, especially for those with the greatest need **The Need**: Behavioral health issues are much more common than many people realize. While one in five people will experience a mental health disorder each year, many more will experience feelings of anxiety or depression unrelated to a mental health disorder. Many of these issues were brought to the forefront during the COVID-19 crisis over the past year, as national attention to mental health increased and the stigma associated with it started to fade.

Provident is working to help all people with behavioral health issues get better and gain the skills to live healthy, happy, and productive lives.

Even through the toughest of times, we are still here, and still committed:

Provident's 24/7 crisis hotlines received over 60,000 calls in 2020, twenty thousand more than the previous year. We help hurting people every day, every year, and one in five of our callers identify as suicidal. **Every hotline call we answer is still free** to those in need and is a chance to change or save a life.

In 2020, 607 children between the ages of 5 and 14 participated in our Afterschool Program at 11 area schools. In the 2020-21 school year we were **still able keep our Afterschool kids engaged** in mental well-being activities, STEAM lessons, and artistic and recreational activities through virtual, in person, and hybrid models.

Throughout the recent time of social distancing, Mary Ryder Home staff were **still able to engage each lady's mental well-being** by providing new and inventive solo-activities and entertainments, in addition to continuing our high level of care. Currently, 51 older adult ladies call Mary Ryder Home "home."

Provident offered mental health counseling and psychiatric services to over 2,000 individuals at offices, schools, homes, and at our Access Center this past year. During the public health pandemic **our services still continued without disruption** and many of our clients continue to visit counselors and psychiatrists through telehealth services.

Our clients range in age from 3 to 84, and 40% of clients report a household income of less than \$30,000. With the support of the community, we are **still able to provide our services at little to no cost** to those who otherwise could not afford to seek help.
