<u>Mission Statement:</u> Building brighter futures through exceptional behavioral health services, especially for those with the greatest need.

Who We Help (165 Years and Counting):

Provident offers accessible **mental health services** to individuals, youth, adults, and older adults, and we train burgeoning clinicians through our intern program. 32% of our clients report a household income of less than \$30,000, and 54% have an annual household income of less than \$50,000. With the support of the community, we can provide professional help at little to no cost to those who otherwise could not afford to seek care.

Provident offers **mental health counseling** to thousands of individuals in offices, schools, and via telehealth. Counseling is also available through our **Access Center**. For \$5, those with financial and accessibility barriers receive same-week support from a Master's level counseling intern. Our goal is to keep those with acute needs safe and out of emergency departments and to connect them with longer-term care.

Support groups for grief and survivors of suicide help us reach those with specific needs.

Our **TeleHope** program offers older adults and their caregivers supportive care over the phone in the comfort of their own homes.

Provident Crisis Services (PCS) is fortunate to have Crisis Intervention Specialists covering our hotlines every moment of every day. Our role as a **988 Suicide Prevention Lifeline and** *Feeling Kinda Blue* crisis center allows us to care for individuals 24/7, assess for suicide, safety plan, connect individuals to resources, and to provide follow up to services to anyone in need.

Provident's **Psychiatric Program** offers psychiatric evaluation and medication management that is so difficult to access. Provident's **five Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitione**rs serve adults and children, ages 5 and older.

Behavioral Health Intervention Specialists support kids, their families, and educators within school campuses. We strive to keep kids mentally healthy.

Mary Ryder Home residents benefit from the **Intensive Residential Treatment Setting (IRTS),** a model that continues to serve and house low-income older adult women with serious and persistent behavioral health diagnoses. Mary Ryder Home offers compassionate and comprehensive care and mental well-being is a top priority for the residents of this program.

Our **Behavioral Health Outreach Specialist** offers community education and outreach to nonprofits and faith-based organizations supporting front-line community members.
